



GUAM WOMEN'S CHAMBER OF COMMERCE (GWCC) SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Applicant must support the mission and vision of the Guam Women's Chamber of Commerce. To demonstrate support, the applicant is encouraged to participate in the annual GWCC Golf Tournament that will be held in September 2017.
2. Applicant must be a full-time student currently enrolled and pursuing a Bachelor's Degree at the University of Guam (UOG).
3. Applicant must have successfully completed at least two (2) semesters at UOG.
4. Applicant must have at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average (GPA).
5. Applicant must provide a current official transcript for proof of current GPA.
6. Applicant must submit a completed GWCC Scholarship Application Form.
7. Applicant must submit two (2) letters of recommendation from two (2) UOG faculty members.
8. Applicant must submit a 500-600 word essay (typewritten, double-space) on one of the following topics:
 - a. How can we advocate for a better business environment that pays competitive wages and benefits for women on Guam?
 - b. What role would the decolonization of Guam have in enhancing or inhibiting economic growth and development on the island?
 - c. Why is having female leaders in positions of influence to serve as role models so important?

Amount and Number of Awards: Two (2) \$1,500 scholarships for Academic Year 2017.

Application Deadline: Application packet must be submitted to the UOG Financial Aid Office no later than July 17, 2017. Incomplete packets will *not* be reviewed.

Selection Process: The UOG Scholarship Committee will recommend applications to GWCC based on the GPA, letters of recommendation, and one-page essays. Final selection will be made by the GWCC Board. Consideration will be given to academic achievement, character, content organization, correct use of grammar, punctuation, spelling, originality and creativity of essay.

Method of Payment: Selected applicant must show proof of UOG registration for Fall 2017 to GWCC before payment is made. Scholarship recipients are expected to attend a GWCC event when the scholarship awards will be presented.
